**RE: Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission Provider of Last Resort  
(POLR) Roundtable M-00041792**

TO ALL PARTIES:

At the Public Meeting of March 4, 2004, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission adopted a motion of Commissioner Glen R. Thomas to convene a POLR Roundtable as a forum for the discussion of issues related to POLR service in Pennsylvania. In so doing, the Commission opened the above captioned docket and ordered as follows:

1. The POLR Roundtable is hereby created as a forum to discuss before Commissioners and Commission staff issues related to POLR service in Pennsylvania.
2. Any interested person shall notify the Secretary's Bureau that they wish to participate and/or present testimony during the POLR Roundtable by March 11, 2004.
3. The Commission shall provide a meeting schedule and issues list to interested participants by March 18, 2004.
4. The POLR Roundtable Meetings shall commence on April 7, 2004 and run no later than June 30, 2004.

The Commission envisions a process whereby the many issues in defining the duties and rights of POLR service in the electric industry can be raised and discussed between the participants, Commissioners, and Commission staff. The meetings will be open to the public, and interested participants will be offered the opportunity to present their views on POLR service to the Commission.

The Commission requests that all parties interested in participating and/or presenting testimony in the POLR Roundtable please submit, in writing, their name, mailing address, e-mail address, telephone number, and the fax number of their designated representative to the Secretary.
