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Approved applications for East Pennsboro Ambulance Service Inc. (**Cumberland, Dauphin and Perry counties**); World Class Ride (**Delaware County**); Jr. Crockett (**Lancaster County**); Visit Vans LLC (**Lehigh and Northampton counties**); All Ways Moving & Storage (**Allegheny, Greene and Washington counties**); Aqua Pennsylvania Inc.; Peninsula Energy Services Co. Inc.; Aqua Pennsylvania Inc. & Total Environmental Solutions Inc. and Suburban Wastewater Co. & Total Environmental Solutions Inc.; 1 800 Collect Inc.; Shorelink Communications Corp.; and GEM Ambulance Inc. (**Philadelphia County**); Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) (**Lawrence County**).

Approved license amendments for Green Mountain Energy Co.; Touch Base Communications; Suburban Wastewater; Aqua Pennsylvania; and Peninsula Energy Services Co. Inc.

Sustained complaints, canceled certificates and/or imposed fines in Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (I&E) vs. Rosemont Taxicab Co. (**Montgomery County**); and BTS (Bureau of Transportation & Safety) vs. Merkato Trans Co. (**Delaware County**).

Made public the auditor's report on the universal service and energy conservation surcharge for Philadelphia Gas Works; and the audit report on the restructuring and consumer-education surcharge of Philadelphia Gas Works.

Adopted the proposed opinions and orders rescinding the secretarial letter issued on July 7, 2011, rendering the petition of appeal from staff action moot in the case of BTS vs. Malik Cab Co. (**Philadelphia County**); denying the exceptions and adopting the administrative law judge's (ALJ's) initial decision in the case of Donna Parsons vs. West Penn Power Co.; granting the petition and modifying the order entered Dec. 1, 2011, to reflect the correct authority for MercyLife Ambulance Inc. (**Philadelphia, Bucks, Montgomery, Chester and Delaware counties**);

denying the complainant's petition and adopting the initial decision in the case of Mary Jane Nestorick vs. UGI Utilities Inc. – Electric Division; denying the complainant's petition and adopting the initial decision in the case of Mary Jane Nestorick vs. UGI Utilities Inc. – Electric Division; approving the settlement agreement, which includes a \$900 civil penalty for the company in the case of Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (I&E) vs. Enterprise Limousine (**Bucks County**); denying the petition for reconsideration in the case of BTS vs. Stephan & Son Trucking Inc.; granting the petition for reconsideration pending further consideration on the merits in the case of Catherine S. Brown vs. PECO Energy Co.; granting the company's exceptions and reverses the ALJ's initial decision in the case of Carla Nixon vs. PECO Energy Co.; denying the complainant's exceptions and adopts the initial decision in the case of Faye Payne vs. Philadelphia Gas Works; granting the petition for reconsideration, in part, and referring the application of South Shore Limousine LLC (**Erie and Crawford counties**) to the Bureau of Technical Utility Services; and granting the petition to the extent outlined, rescinding the Dec. 19, 2011, order, affording the applicant 60 days to submit additional data and referring the matter to the Bureau of Technical Services regarding the application of Daum Transportation (**Bradford County**).

Adopted proposed orders approving the letter of notification of PPL Electric Utilities Corp. with respect to the Reese-Hershey 138/69-kV transmission line in Derry Township, **Dauphin County**; and directing Metropolitan Edison Co., Pennsylvania Electric Co. and Pennsylvania Power Co. to file the reports as specified in the body of this order with regard to their management efficient investigation conducted by the Commission's Bureau of Audits.

Approved increases in rates for Somerset Area Ambulance Assoc. Inc. (**Allegheny, Bedford, Blair, Cambria, Fayette, Westmoreland and Somerset counties**); and Two Men and a Truck (**Allegheny County**).

Adopted the final order encouraging **West Penn Power Co.** to continue with the implementation of the Bureau of Audits' management efficiency investigation recommended measures and noting that the Commission will monitor the company's progress on these remaining recommendations.

Finalized an order as the first step in implementing **Act 127**, the Gas and Hazardous Liquids Pipelines Act.

Denied an increase in rates for Reading Checker Cab Inc. (**Berks County**); Reading Yellow Cab Inc. (**Berks County**); and **approved increase in rates** for Frontier Van Lines Moving & Storage Inc. (**Allegheny, Beaver, Butler, Washington** and **Westmoreland counties**).

Approved the generation supply adjustment for **PECO Energy Co. – Electric**; and the default generation supply service for **UGI Utilities Inc. – Electric Division**.

Approved the 911 system renewal plan for Schuylkill County.

Adopted the initial decision of the ALJ approving and adopting the settlement in the case of BTS vs. Harrisburg City Cabs Inc. (**Dauphin County**) which includes a \$1,000 penalty.

Adopted the ALJ's recommended decision accepting **PECO Energy Co. – Electric's** section 1307(e) electric universal service fund charge reconciliation statement.

Adopted the motion of Vice Chairman Coleman in the case of Daniel Smith vs. **Verizon Pennsylvania Inc.**
