**Approved** the annual system benefits charge for universal service programs and consumer education for **Pike County Light & Power Co. – Electric**; the consumer-education charges for **UGI Utilities Inc., PECO Energy Co. – Electric, Pennsylvania Electric Co. and Metropolitan Edison Co.**; the generation supply adjustment for **PECO Energy Co. – Electric**; and the generation supply service rates for **Citizens' Electric Co. of Lewisburg and Wellsboro Electric Co.**

**Adopted the proposed opinions and orders** denying the complainants' exceptions, granting the respondent's exceptions, in part, modifying the administrative law judge's (ALJ's) initial decision consistent with the order and dismissing the complaint in the case of County Cab Co. (**Philadelphia County**) vs. Oged Inc.; denying

the complainant's exceptions and adopting the ALJ's initial decision, as modified, in the case of Theodore Presutti vs. **Duquesne Light Co.**; denying the protestants' exceptions to the initial decision, adopting the initial decision and granting the application of Yellow Cab Co. of Pittsburgh (**Allegheny County**); approving the settlement agreement in the case of Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (I&E) vs. Javy Enterprises Inc. (**Beaver County**); granting the petition for reconsideration pending review of, and consideration on, the merits regarding the application to amend its paratransit authority to include several counties of American Eagle Bus & Limo Inc. (**Pike, Susquehanna, Wayne, and Wyoming counties**); denying the exceptions and modifying the initial decision in the case of Larry and Gail Newman vs. **Philadelphia Gas Works**; granting the joint petition for approval of amendment to an interconnection agreement between **Bandwidth.com CLEC LLC and Verizon North Inc.**; and granting the joint petition for approval of amendment to an interconnection agreement between **Bandwidth.com CLEC LLC and Verizon Pennsylvania Inc.**

**Adopted the proposed final order** that it be the policy of the Commission to interpret the term "operator" in the definition of "customer-generator" as including customer-generators with **distributed alternative energy systems** that contract with a third party to perform the operational functions of the system there are limitations on the inclusion of that with third-party contracts.

**Approved the proposed rate increase for Quentin Water Co.**

**Adopted a petition** filed by **PECO Energy Co. – Electric** of four demand response contracts with for demand response service in connection with the company's energy efficiency and conservation plan.

**Approved** the request for waivers from the consumer-education tariff rider for **West Pennsylvania Power Co.**

**Approved the 911 system renewal plans for Cambria County.**

**Adopted the ALJ's recommended decisions** approving the settlement regarding the requested rate increase of Fairview Sanitation Co. (**Erie County**); approving the settlement without modification regarding the requested rate increase of Penn Estates Utilities Inc. (**Monroe County**); accepting the Section 1307(e) gas cost rate reconciliation statement insofar as it is undisputed setting forth the over/under collections for the period which ended Aug. 31, 2011, for **North East Heat & Light Co.**; accepting the Section 1307(e) transmission service charge reconciliation statement insofar as it is undisputed setting forth the over/under collections for the period which ended on Oct. 31, 2011, for **PECO Energy Co. – Electric**; approving the reconciliation statement insofar as it is undisputed for **PPL Electric Utilities Corp.'s** universal service rider for the year ended Nov. 30, 2011; approving the reconciliation statement insofar as it is undisputed for **Pennsylvania Power Co.'s** universal service charge for the year ended Oct. 31, 2011; approving the reconciliation statement insofar as it is undisputed for **Metropolitan Edison Co.'s** universal service charge for the year ended Oct. 31, 2011; approving the reconciliation statement insofar as it is undisputed for **Pennsylvania Electric Co.'s** universal service charge for the year ended Oct. 31, 2011.
