**Adopted the proposed extension order** of the fuel cost recovery surcharge for **Tri-State Household Goods Tariff Conference** for an additional year, effective April 18, 2012.

**Approved applications** for Late Nite Loop (**Berks County**); **Blue Pilot Energy LLC**; **WhiteFence Inc.**; **National 1 Energy LLC**; and **Agway Energy Services LLC** and amended application of **CBB Carrier Services Inc.**

**Approved the license amendments for EnergyMark LLC.**

**Approved an application for discontinuance or abandonment of service** for David W. Hayes (**Blair County**).

**Denied or dismissed the applications** of **Business Power Solutions LLC**; **Affordable Parts & Service Inc.** (**Luzerne County**); and **AJ&M Limo Service LLC.**

**Made public** the original cost study for the Jefferson Estates Sewage Treatment Plant (**Fayette County**).

**Adopted the proposed opinions and orders** denying the instant petition to appeal staff action filed by the company regarding the complaint filed against On Time Delivery Inc. (**Allegheny, Armstrong, Beaver, Butler, Fayette, Washington and Westmoreland counties**) alleging that it failed to maintain evidence of insurance on file with the Commission; denying the exceptions and dismissing the complaints in the case of 1-A Realty vs. **PPL Electric Utilities Corp.**; denying the instant petition and the motion for reconsideration in the case of Gerald S. Lepre Jr. vs. **Equitable Gas Co.**; granting reconsideration pending further review of the merits of the petition and denying the late-filed

motion for certification of interlocutory order for immediate appeal in the case of Consolidated Communications Enterprise Services vs. **T-Mobile et al**; denying the complainant's exceptions and adopting the administrative law judge's (ALJ's) initial decision in the case of Montagna Homes vs. **National Fuel Gas Distribution Corp.**

**Adopted the proposed orders** granting the petition for waiver of 52 Pa. Code Section 31.121 that requires moves that are fewer than 40 miles to be based on an hourly rate and moves over 40 miles to be charged according to weight and mileage for **Modern Piano Moving**; approving the application of **PPL Electric Utilities Corp.** for the siting and construction of the East Tannersville No. 1 and No. 2 138-kV tap line in Pocono Township, Monroe County, and granting the petition for approval for a finding that a building to shelter control equipment for the line is reasonably necessary; approving Tariff Gas-Pa. P.U.C. No. 9 for **National Fuel Gas Distribution Corp.**, proposing a number of revisions and updates to various sections of the tariff; granting the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation's (PennDOT) (**Butler County**) petition to transfer jurisdiction of the right-of-way plan -- to alter the public at-grade crossing by realigning State Route 4006 where it crosses the single track of the Bessemer & Lake Erie Railroad in Slippery Rock Township, Butler County -- to the Court of Common Pleas of Butler County; and granting the petition to withdraw the petition seeking **eligible telecommunications carrier status** in Pennsylvania for **DPI-Teleconnect LLC.**

**Denied the petition of Trans-Allegheny Interstate Line Co. (TrAILCo)** requesting waiver of the strict requirements of 52 Pa. Code Section 57.72 relating to review of **siting and construction of electrical transmission lines.**

**Approved the 911 system renewal plans for Elk and Monroe counties.**

**Adopted the ALJ's initial decision** dismissing the complaint with prejudice for failure to prosecute in the case of Beverly Dillard vs. **Duquesne Light Co.**

**Approved West Penn Power Co.'s** proposed Tariff Supplement No. 214 to Tariff Electric – Pa. P.U.C. No. 39, reflecting the FirstEnergy Corp. **merger credit** of \$0.49 per month, to become effective April 25, 2012.

**Registered the securities certificate** of **RCN Telecom Services (Lehigh) LLC** and **RCN Telecom Services of Philadelphia LLC.**

**Read the joint statement of Chairman Powelson and Commissioner Witmer on the Green Button Initiative.**
