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Approved applications for M&L Transportation Inc. (**Lancaster County**); Ace Transit Management LLC (**Philadelphia County**); Star Express Transport LLC (**Dauphin County**); **Princeton Hosted Solutions LLC**; **Verdigris Energy LLC**; and **York Water Co. – Wastewater and Asbury Pointe Water and Sewer Co.**

Made public the audit report of the consumer education charge for the 12 months ended Dec. 31, 2009, for **Metropolitan Edison Co.** and **Pennsylvania Electric Co.**; the **audit report of the transmission service charge** for the 12 months ended Feb. 28, 2011, for **Duquesne Light Co.**; the **audit report of the consumer education charge** for the years ended Dec. 31, 2010, Dec. 31, 2009, and Dec. 31, 2008, for **Duquesne Light Co.**; and the **audit report on the energy efficiency and conservation and demand response surcharge** for the 12 months ended May 31, 2011, and for the six months ended Dec. 31, 2010, for **Duquesne Light Co.**

Approved the Alternative Energy Portfolio Standards surcharge for **PECO Energy Co. – Electric**; the generation supply adjustment for **PECO Energy Co. – Gas**; and the contractor selected to advise the Commission regarding local zoning and municipality law, to aid in the implementation of **Act 13 of 2012.**

Baylor (**Philadelphia County**); reversing the initial decision, remanding the matter to the Office of Administrative Law Judge for further action as deemed necessary and orders the respondent to have its attorney file a notice of appearance in the case of Bureau of Transportation and Safety (BTS) vs. Okey Cab Co. (**Philadelphia County**); adopting the proposed settlement regarding an informal investigation of **Equitable Gas Co.** regarding the transfer of intellectual property to EQT IP Ventures LLC and affiliated interest transactions with EQT IP Ventures LLC; granting the company's exceptions, in part, denying the company's exceptions, in part, and modifying the initial decision, consistent with the discussion therein, in the case of Stanley Elliott vs. **PECO Energy Co.**; denying the exceptions and adopting the administrative law judge's (ALJ's) initial decision in the case of Harold Goldstein vs. **Metropolitan Edison Co.**; granting the complainant's exceptions and modifying the special agent's initial decision in the case of William Femea Sr. vs. **UGI Penn Natural Gas**; denying the petition for reconsideration in the case of Cassie Wright vs. **PECO Energy Co.**; granting the petition for reconsideration pending review of, and consideration on, the merits regarding the application of AJ&M Limo Service LLC (**Montgomery, Bucks, Chester, Delaware and Philadelphia counties**); granting the joint petition for approval of an amendment to an interconnection connection agreement between **Comcast Phone of Pennsylvania LLC** and **Verizon Pennsylvania Inc.**; granting the joint petition for approval of an amendment to an interconnection agreement between **Comcast Phone of Pennsylvania LLC** and **Verizon North Inc.**; granting the joint petition for approval of an amendment to an interconnection agreement

Adopted the proposed orders approving the letter of notification of **PPL Electric Utilities Corp.** with respect to the South Akron-Prince No. 1 and No. 2 transmission line in the townships of West Earl, Warwick, Manheim, Upper Leacock and East Lampeter, and the City of Lancaster, **Lancaster County**; approving the registration of the securities certificate and the affiliated interest agreement for **Equitable Gas Co.**; withdrawing the proposed rulemaking regarding **universal service and energy conservation reporting requirements**; and staying certain intrastate switched carrier access rate reforms directed by the Commission's July 18, 2011 order, because of the implementation of **Federal Communications Commission (FCC)** directives, prescribing templates for tariff supplements, and protective order.

Adopted the proposed final order of the Commission's Electronic Data Exchange Working Group, adopting change controls No. 085, addressing **net metering**, and No. 087, addressing **account peak load**.

Approved the tentative implementation order on the future of energy efficiency and conservation (EE&C) programs established under **Act 129 of 2008**.

Granted, in part, and denied, in part, the petition of **Full Service Network LP** for extension of the current waiver of various Chapter 64 regulations as applied to pre-paid landline service.

Adopted the final implementation order finalizing provisions of **Act 13 of 2012** related to the collection and disbursement of the impact fee for unconventional natural gas well drilling.

Issued for comment a tentative order that begins the implementation of **Act 11 of 2012**, which among other things, provides for a **distribution system improvement charge (DSIC)** for electric, natural gas, water and wastewater utilities.

Registered securities certificates for Newtown Artesian Water Co.

Adopted the ALJ's recommended decision on further remand approving of the stipulation of counsel with modification regarding the investigation into the **Southeastern Pennsylvania Transit Authority's** maintenance responsibility of the crossing carrying 41st Street above the grade of the tracks of Amtrak and Conrail, in Philadelphia; and approving the petition for settlement and the motion to admit into evidence the company's direct testimony in support of the new plan, regarding **West Penn Power Company's** original energy efficiency and conservation/demand response plan filed on June 30, 2009, in conformity with the requirements of **Act 129 of 2008**.
