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Approved applications for Pennsylvania Taxicab and Paratransit Association; Community Integrations LLC (**Centre County**); Pearl Express LLC (**York County**); Park Avenue Luxury Limousine Inc. (**Philadelphia County**); Hallcon Crew Transport Inc.; Auto Effects Motor Sports Inc. (**Beaver County**); **Air Star Transportation and Limousine Service Inc., Classy Cab Co. Inc., Cranberry Taxi Inc. and Star Limousine Service Inc.; Early Bird Power LLC; RJT Energy Consultants LLC; Custom Tel LLC; IBC Telecom Corp.; Televergence Solutions Inc.; MIPC LLC and Phillips 66 Pipeline LLC.; and Pennsylvania American Water Co.**

Approved applications as amended for Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (Cumberland County); Just Energy Pennsylvania Corp.; and MidAmerican Energy Co.

Approved the application for discontinuance or abandonment of service for Price Point Energy LLC.

Made public the Telecommunications Relay Service program audit for the 10 months ended Feb. 28, 2009, and for the 12 months ended April 30, 2008, and April 30, 2007.

Approved the vendor selected as the administrator of the **Pennsylvania Universal Service Fund**; the computation in accordance with Section 3015 of the Public Utility Code of the amount of the assessments for the **Broadband Outreach and Aggregation Fund** for Fiscal Year 2012-2013; **the generation supply adjustment for PECO Energy Co. – Electric;** and the **generation supply service rates for Wellsboro Electric Co. and Citizens' Electric Co. of Lewisburg.**

Adopted the proposed opinions and orders denying PPL Industrial Customer Alliance's (PPLICIA) request for a special rate for Donsco Inc. as part of **PPL Electric Utilities Corp.'s** base rate proceeding. ; denying the exceptions of the applicant and adopting the administrative law judge's (ALJ's) initial decision regarding the application of Veterans Taxi (**Allegheny County**); denying the exceptions and modifying the initial decision in the case of James Munro vs. **PECO Energy Co.**; denying the complainant's exceptions and adopting the ALJ's initial decision in the case of Willie Jessie vs. **Philadelphia Gas Works**; denying the petition requesting reinstatement of a certificate and waiver of the civil penalty in the case of Bureau of Transportation and Safety (BTS) vs. The Reading Express Airport Shuttle (**Berks County**); denying the exceptions the exceptions filed by the Utility Workers Union of America System Local 537 on May 7, 2012, and the exceptions filed by the Office of Consumer Advocate on May 7, 2012, and granting the motion to dismiss of Pennsylvania American Water Co. in the case of Utility Workers Union of America System Local 537 vs. **Pennsylvania American Water Co.** and Granting the reconsideration pending review of the merits in the instant application of **Quality Transport Services Inc.**

Adopted the proposed orders establishing a revised schedule for mailing of certain consumer-education materials with regarding to the **investigation of Pennsylvania's retail electricity market**; approving the letter of notification of **PPL Electric Utilities Corp.** regarding the Blooming Grove-Hemlock No. 1 and No. 2 138/69-kV transmission line rebuild in Blooming Grove Township, **Pike County**; approving the **2012 price stability index/service price indexes** for **Windstream Pennsylvania LLC, Windstream D&E**

Inc., Windstream Conestoga Inc., Windstream Buffalo Valley Inc., North-Eastern Pennsylvania Telephone Co., Hickory Telephone Co., Bentleyville Communications Corp., Marianna and Scenery Hill Co. and Consolidated Communications of Pennsylvania Co.; approving Supplement No. 4 to Tariff Water-Pa. P.U.C. No. 7 proposing the creation of a purchase water adjustment charge for **Utilities Inc. – Westgate**; granting the petition for a four-year extension of the two-year trial period permitting **AT&T Communications of Pennsylvania, TCG New Jersey** and **TCG Pittsburgh** to maintain information about the rates, terms and conditions for basic dial tone service offered to enterprise and large business customers on its internet website; granting **Pike County Light & Power Co. – Electric’s** petition for authority to defer for accounting and financial reporting purposes certain expenses from damage caused to its property by Hurricane Irene in August 2011, and to amortize such expenses subject to conditions; granting the petition of **Budget Phone** for limited designation as an **eligible telecommunications carrier (ETC)** for the purpose of offering **Lifeline service**; and granting the petition of **T-Mobile Northeast LLC, T-Mobile Central LLC, and VoiceStream Pittsburgh LP** for conditional designation as an ETC in areas eligible for Federal Mobility Fund Phase I support in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Approved the proposed rate increases for Sunoco Pipeline, LP.

Registered securities certificates for Pennsylvania American Water Co. and Consolidated Communications of Pennsylvania Co.

Approved the 911 system renewal plans for Allegheny and Clinton counties.

Adopted the ALJ’s initial decision sustaining the complaint regarding the second meter and dismissing the complaint regarding high bills in the case of Samy Azer vs. **PPL Electric Utilities Corp.**

Adopted the ALJ’s recommended decisions accepting the Section 1307(e) statement of over/under collections of the distribution system improvement charge for the 12-month period ended Dec. 31, 2011, for **York Water Co.** and **United Water Pennsylvania Inc.**; accepting the Section 1307(e) statement of actual code adjustment rate of over/under collection for the 12-month period ended Jan. 31, 2012, for **Borough of Schuylkill Haven – Electric.**

Adopted the joint motion of Vice Chairman Coleman and Commissioner Witmer regarding **UGI Central Penn Gas’s** rate request and the company’s voluntary energy efficiency and conservation measures.
