Dear Judge Rainey:

On October 23, 2009, the Commission entered an Order at Docket No. M-00072021 approving a Settlement entered into between Philadelphia Gas Works ("PGW"), the Office of Trial Staff ("OTS"), and the Tenant Union Representative Network/Action alliance of Senior Citizens of Greater Philadelphia ("TURN *et al.*"). The Settlement implemented changes to PGW's Universal Service Plan pursuant to directives from the Department of Public Welfare ("DPW") modifying the application of discounts applied to Customer Responsibility Program ("CRP") participants. As a condition of the Settlement, PGW agreed to file, by January 31, 2010 and separately from its next base rate case, a proposal to implement further changes to the CRP Program. The Settling Parties agreed to consider changes to PGW's CRP in the separate docket.


Due to the parties' agreement to extend PGW's January 31, 2010 filing date and the ongoing discussions regarding PGW's proposed CRP modifications, OTS will withdraw parts of OTS Statement No. 3, the direct testimony of OTS Witness Amanda Gordon, which was distributed to the parties on March 26, 2010. The text from page 10, line 1 through page 14, line 2 of OTS Statement No. 3 and the entirety of Schedule 5 to OTS Exhibit No. 3 will not be entered into the record in this proceeding.

OTS is providing this notification of its intent in advance of the submission of testimony at the Evidentiary Hearings so that the affected parties are aware of the withdrawal of this issue and can respond accordingly.
