Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Hess Corporation ("Hess") respectfully requests amendment of its electric generation supplier ("EGS") license to include service to residential customers and small commercial and industrial ("small C&I") customers (25 kW and below) throughout the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Hess has significant experience serving large commercial and industrial customers in Pennsylvania as well as numerous states and, while Hess does not anticipate marketing to residential and small C&I customers in the near future, Hess is well-equipped to provide such service and therefore requests approval of this amendment.

Hess acquired its current license through a series of corporate transfers and restructurings. The license was originally granted to Eastern Power Division, Inc. on May 8, 1997 and gave the licensee the right to provide electric generation supplier services to commercial and industrial customers within the Commonwealth. By Secretarial Letter dated August 18, 1998, the Commission approved the transfer of the license from Eastern Power Distribution, Inc. to Hess Energy, Inc. (then d/b/a Statoil Energy Services, Inc.). By Commission Order entered July 19, 2002, the license was transferred from Hess Energy, Inc. to Amerada Hess Corporation. Finally, by Secretarial Letter dated July 5, 2006, the Commission approved the request to change the name on the license to Hess Corporation.

In support of this requested amendment, Hess submits as **Attachment A** its proposed Disclosure Statement as required by 52 Pa. Code § 54.5. This Disclosure Statement has been approved by Staff from the Bureau of Consumer Services (BCS). Lisa Weary and/or Dave Mick in BCS can be contacted to confirm this review. Also, given the length of time and corporate transactions that have passed since Hess' license was first approved, Hess has published a notice of this filing in all seven newspapers of general circulation covering every county in the Commonwealth. **Attachment B** includes the proofs of publication.



Hess Corporation Disclosure Statement

This is an agreement for electric generation service, between Hess Corporation and customer's name and full address.

Background

- We at Hess Corporation are licensed by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission to offer and supply electric generation services in Pennsylvania. Our PUC license number is A-110005.
- We set the generation prices and charges that you pay. The Public Utility Commission regulates distribution prices and services. The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission regulates transmission prices and services.

You will receive a single bill from billing agent name that will contain distribution utility name charges and Hess Corporation's charges.

- Right of Rescission - You may cancel this agreement in writing or orally at any time before midnight of the third business day after receiving this disclosure.

Definitions

- Generation Charge - Charge for production of electricity.
- Transmission Charge - Charge for moving high voltage electricity from a generation facility to the distribution lines of an electric distribution company.

Terms of Service

1. (a) Basic Service Price:

You will pay [price] per kWh for electric generation service.

This price includes Generation Charges and Transmission Charges, and estimated current total state taxes, including current Gross Receipts Taxes, but excludes applicable state and local sales taxes."

2. **Length of Agreement** - You will buy your electricity generation service for the above street address from Hess Corporation beginning date through date of expiration, if any.

3. **Penalties, Fees and Exceptions** - Customer is responsible for all costs and fees, including reasonable attorney's fees, incurred in collecting payment or resulting from customer-initiated early cancellation. Hess Corporation does not impose an early cancellation fee but any costs imposed on Hess as a result of a customer-initiated early cancellation will be the responsibility of the customer.

4. **Cancellation Provisions** – The Agreement may be canceled for the following reasons:
(i) non-payment: if your electric service is terminated by your electric distribution company, then this agreement is cancelled on the date that your service is terminated. **(ii) company-initiated cancellation:** if we cancel this agreement for any reason other than customer non-payment, we will follow applicable rules in providing notice to you. **(iii) customer-initiated cancellation:** if you cancel your agreement before the end of the initial term, you may be subjected to the penalties, fees and exceptions described above. **(iv) failure of either Party to satisfy any representations and warranties contained in Section 13 and the failure is not cured within fifteen (15) Business Days of a written demand.**

7. **Renewal Provision/Agreement Expiration/Change in Terms**
If you have a fixed term agreement with us and it is approaching the expiration date or whenever we propose to change our terms of service in any type of agreement, you will receive two advance notices from us in either your bill or in separate mailings between 45 and 90 days before the expiration date or proposed change date. We will explain your options to you in these two advance notifications.'

8. **Dispute Procedures**
Contact us with any questions concerning our terms of service. You may call the PUC if you are not satisfied after discussing your terms with us.






