I. HISTORY

The Community Action Association of Pennsylvania (CAAP) intervened in these matters by individual Petitions to Intervene all of which were filed on December 14, 2012. CAAP is a statewide association representing Pennsylvania’s community action agencies that provide anti-poverty planning and community development activities for low income communities and services to individuals and families. CAAP has intervened in prior matters before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission for the purpose of addressing energy issues that involve its low income clients. CAAP intervened in these matters in large part to address the portion of the Companies’ Plans that concerns low income customers.


