Based on representations made by both the Philadelphia Gas Works ("PGW") and the Natural Gas Supplier Parties ("NGS Parties"), the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement ("I&E") respectfully requests that the scheduling of the Prehearing Conference sought in its December 27, 2012 correspondence be considered for April 16, 2013. I&E believes that the scheduling of the Prehearing Conference on this date will allow for adequate time to finalize the issues that have been addressed since the last collaborative meeting while maintaining the integrity of the litigation process by ensuring the orderly progression of this proceeding.

The compromises and agreements that have been offered in the PGW and NGS Parties' representations to I&E indicate that resolution of this proceeding may, indeed, be obtained without Evidentiary Hearings. In the event discussions falter, a litigation schedule can be developed at the scheduled Prehearing Conference. In order to effectuate continued discussions while protecting the interests of all parties, I&E, PGW and the NGS Parties agree to the scheduling of the Prehearing Conference for April 16, 2013.
