**PETITION FOR LEAVE TO WITHDRAW PECO ENERGY COMPANY'S 2013
CONSUMER EDUCATION PLAN**

Pursuant to 52 Pa.Code § 1.82, PECO Energy Company (“PECO” or the “Company”) hereby files this Petition to withdraw its *Petition for Approval of its 2013 Consumer Education Plan* at Docket No. P-2012-2335025 (“Plan Petition”), filed with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (the “Commission”) on November 19, 2012.¹

PECO’s Plan Petition explained that under its proposed 2013 Consumer Education Plan the Company would initiate its second annual Commission-endorsed postcard mailing by February 2013.² However, the Commission issued a Secretarial Letter on December 20, 2012, which dispensed with the 2013 postcard mailing requirement “to avoid overwhelming consumers.”

Because the December 20 Secretarial Letter directed EDCs not to mail Commission-endorsed postcards in 2013, PECO is requesting leave to withdraw its Plan Petition. Consequently, a Commission ruling is not needed and withdrawal of PECO’s Plan Petition is in

¹ The Plan Petition was a supplement to PECO’s Consumer Education Plan for 2008-2012, which was approved as modified by the Commission on August 8, 2008 in Docket No. M-2008-2032274.

² The annual postcard mailing requirement was adopted in the Commission’s Retail Markets Investigation (“RMI”) at Docket No. I-2011-2237952. Specifically, the Commission’s Final Order and Intermediate Work Plan of March 2, 2012 indicated that the Commission-endorsed postcard shall be re-established on an annual basis.

the public interest. Therefore, PECO respectfully requests that the Commission grant its request to withdraw its Plan Petition.

CONCLUSION

PECO respectfully requests that the Commission approve its request to withdraw its *Petition for Approval of its 2013 Consumer Education Plan*.


