RE: License Bond or Other Financial Security

Dear Mr. Waisner:

Pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. §2809(c), no energy supplier license shall remain in force unless the licensee furnishes a bond or other security approved by the Commission to ensure the financial responsibility of the electric generation supplier and the supply of electricity at retail. The Commission's records pertinent to your Company indicate that the bond or other approved security posted for CNG Retail Services Corporation expired on April 1, 1999. In order for your Company to maintain its status as a licensed electric supplier in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, it must provide proof to the Commission that a bond or other approved security has been obtained.

Your response in this matter is requested within ten (10) days of the date of this letter.
