RE: License Bond or Other Financial Security

Dear Mr. Kooper:

Pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. §2809(c), no electric supplier license shall remain in force unless the licensee furnishes a bond or other security approved by the Commission to ensure the financial responsibility of the electric generation supplier and the supply of electricity at retail. The Commission's records indicate that the bond or other approved security provided by Hess Corporation expires on March 31, 2007.

The Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code §54.40(d) require "the security level for each licensee will be reviewed annually and modified primarily based upon the licensee's reported annual gross receipts information. The security level will be 10% of the licensee's reported gross receipts." The minimum security level provided may not be less than the initial security level provided when the license was granted. Unless approved by the Commission, the initial security level is \$250,000.

The Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code §54.39(b) require a licensee to file an annual report on or before April 30 of each year, for the previous calendar year, in order to comply with 66 Pa. C.S. §2810(c)(6). This report discloses the total amount of gross receipts from the sale of electricity and the total amount of electricity sold during the preceding calendar year. You must use this same information in calculating the appropriate security level necessary to maintain your license.

In order for your company to maintain its status as a licensed electric supplier in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, it must provide proof to the Commission that a bond or other approved security has been obtained.

Your response in this matter is requested within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter. Submit your response to the Commission's Secretary. Additionally, fax a copy of your response to James Shurskis at (717) 787-4750, Bureau of Fixed Utility Services.

Failure to respond to this matter within fifteen (15) days will cause Commission staff to initiate a formal proceeding, that may lead to the following: cancellation of your company's electric supplier license, removal of your information from the Commission's website and notification to all electric distribution companies, in which your company is licensed to do business, of the cancellation of the license.

Dear Secretary McNulty:

I am writing to apprise you of recent changes in Hess Corporation's ("Hess") Regulatory Affairs Department. In an effort to provide better focus on each commodity, Hess has separated Regulatory Affairs into two separate divisions – one that will focus on electric regulatory and compliance matters and one that will focus on natural gas regulatory and compliance matters. We feel that this change will enhance our already strong regulatory participation and enable us to work even more closely with Commissioners and Staff in both areas.

Under this new structure, I will continue in my role as Director of Regulatory Affairs for Hess for all electric regulatory and compliance matters. All natural gas regulatory and compliance matters will now be handled by Debra Rednik, who recently joined Hess as our new Director of Regulatory Affairs for natural gas. Debi comes to Hess from KeySpan Corporation, where as Senior Counsel she was involved in numerous energy regulatory matters, including KeySpan's recent approval from the New York State Public Service Commission for its merger with National Grid.

Previously, Marissa worked as an attorney for the St. Louis, Missouri-based law firm of Evans & Dixon, where she actively represented clients in various cases before the

RE: License Bond or Other Financial Security

Dear Mr. Kooper:

Pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. §2809(c), no electric supplier license shall remain in force unless the licensee furnishes a bond or other security approved by the Commission to ensure the financial responsibility of the electric generation supplier and the supply of electricity at retail. The Commission's records indicate that the expiration of the bond or other approved security provided by Hess Corporation occurs on March 31, 2010.

The Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code §54.40(d) require "the security level for each licensee will be reviewed annually and modified primarily based upon the licensee's reported annual gross receipts information. The security level will be 10% of the licensee's reported gross receipts." The minimum security level provided may not be less than the initial security level provided when the license was granted. Unless approved by the Commission, the initial security level is \$250,000.

The Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code §54.39(b) require a licensee to file an annual report on or before April 30 of each year, for the previous calendar year, in order to comply with 66 Pa. C.S. §2810(c)(6). This report discloses the total amount of gross receipts from the sale of electricity and the total amount of electricity sold during the preceding calendar year. You must use this same information in calculating the appropriate security level necessary to maintain your license.

In order for your company to maintain its status as a licensed electric supplier in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, it must provide proof to the Commission that a bond or other approved security has been obtained.

Your response in this matter is requested within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter. Submit your response to the Commission's Secretary. Additionally, fax a copy of your response to James Shurskis at (717) 787-4750, Bureau of Fixed Utility Services.

Failure to respond to this matter within fifteen (15) days will cause Commission staff to initiate a formal proceeding, that may lead to the following: cancellation of your company's electric supplier license, removal of your information from the Commission's website and notification to all electric distribution companies, in which your company is licensed to do business, of the cancellation of the license.
