**Re: Assignment of Electrical Generation Supplier Accounts  
of Allegheny Energy Supply to Dominion Peoples Plus**

The purpose of this notice is to inform the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission of the assignment of certain retail electrical generation supplier (EGS) accounts of Allegheny Energy Supply Company, L.L.C. to Dominion Peoples Plus, a division of Dominion Resources, Inc., a licensed EGS. The EGS customers affected by the transaction are all those customers served by Allegheny Energy Supply in the geographic electrical distribution service area of Duquesne Light Company. The customers number approximately 105,000, and include residential and commercial customers.

The accounts will be assigned to Dominion Peoples Plus on or about June 15, 2002. The terms and conditions, including pricing, of EGS service will remain the same after the transfer. One exception to the indistinguishable terms and conditions to be provided after the transfer will be that customers who currently receive a separate bill from Allegheny Energy Supply for EGS service and one from the electrical distribution company (Duquesne Light) for EDC service will, after the transfer, receive a combined bill from the electrical distribution company showing both EGS and EDC service.

All affected customers of Allegheny Energy Supply will be notified of the assignment of their accounts. The notification will be made through individual letters mailed to the customers on or about the date of the assignment. Attached hereto are

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

copies of the notice that will be sent to affected residential customers. "Attachment A" is a copy of the notice to be sent to residential customers who currently receive one bill for EGS and EDC service. "Attachment B" is a copy of the notice to be sent to residential customers who currently receive separate bills for EGS and EDC service. "Attachment C" is a copy of the notice that will be sent to all commercial customers.

Affected customers will first see a bill showing Dominion Peoples Plus as providing them EGS service approximately 40 to 70 days after receiving the notice provided in the attached letter.

RE: License Bond or Other Financial Security

Dear Mr. Butler:

Pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. §2809(c), no electric supplier license shall remain in force unless the licensee furnishes a bond or other security approved by the Commission to ensure the financial responsibility of the electric generation supplier and the supply of electricity at retail. The Commission's records indicate that the bond or other approved security provided by Dominion Retail, Inc. expires on 4/1/2003.

The Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code §54.40(d) require "the security level for each licensee will be reviewed annually and modified primarily based upon the licensee's reported annual gross receipts information. The security level will be 10% of the licensee's reported gross receipts." The minimum security level provided may not be less than the initial security level provided when the license was granted. Unless approved by the Commission, the initial security level is \$250,000.

The Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code §54.39(b) require a licensee to file an annual report on or before April 30 of each year, for the previous calendar year, in order to comply with 66 Pa. C.S. §2810(c)(6). This report discloses the total amount of gross receipts from the sale of electricity and the total amount of electricity sold during the preceding calendar year. You must use this same information in calculating the appropriate security level necessary to maintain your license.

In order for your company to maintain its status as a licensed electric supplier in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, it must provide proof to the Commission that a bond or other approved security has been obtained.

Your response in this matter is requested within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter. Submit your response to the Commission's Secretary. Additionally, fax a copy of your response to James Shurskis at (717) 787-4750, Bureau of Fixed Utility Services.

Failure to respond to this matter within fifteen (15) days will cause Commission staff to initiate a formal proceeding, that may lead to the following: cancellation of your company's electric supplier license, removal of your information from the Commission's website and notification to all electric distribution companies, in which your company is licensed to do business, of the cancellation of the license.
