AFFIDAVIT

THIS AFFIDAVIT is executed this 1st day of May 2002, by JEFFREY L. JONES, Director, Retail Electric Commodity Operations, Dominion Retail, Inc. 625 Liberty Avenue, Pittsburgh, PA 15222.

1. Dominion Retail, Inc. ("Dominion") is licensed as an "electric generation supplier" by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission at License No. A-110008.
2. Dominion does not own or operate any electric generation facilities nor is Dominion a party to any power purchase contract under which Dominion purchases a specific block of power generated by a particular fuel source for resale to Pennsylvania retail consumers. Dominion has an arrangement with an electric power generator whereby Dominion purchases certificates evidencing the generation by that party outside of Pennsylvania of a specified quantity of power generated from renewable energy sources for introduction of same into the wholesale electric grid. However, because of the laws regarding electricity flow, Dominion is not able to state with certainty that such energy is actually delivered to Pennsylvania consumers.
3. Therefore, for purposes of reporting to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, Dominion is unable to distinguish and identify by fuel source the origin of the power it acquires for resale to retail customers in Pennsylvania.
