<b>Medium Non-Residential</b>	<b>120,451 to 2,409,000 kWh annual usage (500kW * 55%load factor * 8760 hours in the year)</b>
<b>Large Non-Residential</b>	<b>2,409,001 kWh annual usage and greater</b>


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
