Dear Mr. Stewart:

The Commission's Regulation at 52 Pa. Code 54.37(b) states that:

Completed applications, with all supporting documentation, including any documentation or clarifying information requested by Commission staff, if unopposed, will be processed within 45 days after acceptance by the Commission. If the application is not processed within the time period, the application will be deemed approved. The review period may be extended for a reasonable period of time by Secretarial Letter.
