Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

The purpose of this letter is to provide notice, as required by the Commission's Order at, *Interim Guidelines Regarding Notification of Operational Changes Affecting Customer Service and Contracts*, Docket No. M-00960890F.0013 (Order Entered August 14, 1998), that Dominion Retail, Inc. d/b/a Dominion Energy Solutions ("DES") will assign all of its electricity generation supply customers in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, to Reliant Energy Northeast LLC d/b/a NRG Residential Solutions and NRG Business Solutions ("Reliant"). The assignment is necessitated by DES's corporate decision to exit the retail electricity supply business. Reliant is licensed as an Electric Generation Supplier in Pennsylvania and its license number is A-2010-2192350.

DES will assign to Reliant approximately [ ] residential customer accounts and approximately [ ] non-residential customer accounts. The Assignment will take place on meter reads on and after [ ]. Notices to customers will be provided as early as [ ]. It is difficult to estimate when the assignment of all affected customers will be completed, due to the variance in EDC meter reading schedules but expect, at the latest, that it will completed by [ ].

A thirty (30)-day notice substantially in the form of the notice attached as Exhibit A is being sent to the impacted customers to inform them of the contract transfer. This notice includes the following information:

1. The transfer of service from DES to Reliant (d/b/a as either NRG Residential Solutions in the case of residential customers or NRG Business Solutions in the case of non-residential customers) on the first meter read date occurring after May 13, 2014.
2. Reliant is located at PO Box 38781, Philadelphia, PA 19104.
3. The telephone number for customer service representatives dedicated to residential customers is 1-855-692-8331, and to business non-residential customers is 1-888-315-1558.
4. An explanation of the reason for the contract assignment is as follows: Dominion is exiting the retail electricity market in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
5. Dominion and Reliant request that the Commission grant this notification confidential and proprietary treatment. The data provided herein is commercially sensitive information that Dominion and Reliant do not make public in any of our *corporate reporting*.


