

AND NOW, comes Dominion Retail, Inc. d/b/a Dominion Energy Solutions, ("DES") by and through its counsel in the above-captioned matter, Hawke McKeon & Sniscak LLP, and hereby Petitions the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission"), for authorization to abandon its electric generation supplier ("EGS") license that was first conferred by Commission Order entered on June 2, 1997 at Docket No. A-110008. In support of its Petition, DES states and avers as follows:

1. On March 14, 1997, then CNG Retail Services Corporation filed an application at Docket No. A-110008, seeking a license as an EGS throughout the Commonwealth, pursuant to the then newly enacted *Electricity Generation Customer Choice and Competition Act*, 66 Pa.C.S. §2801, *et seq.* By Order entered June 2, 1997, the Commission granted the requested license on an interim basis.

2. On January 26, 1999, the Commission entered an Order making the license permanent.

3. Until recently, DES has provided service as an EGS in most, if not all, of the Electric Distribution Company service territories in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

4. On April 1, 2014, DES provided the Commission with a Notice of Assignment indicating that it was assigning its customers to a different EGS and that it would eventually cease its operations as an EGS, once all customers had been transferred.


5. As of this date, DES no longer serves any retail customers as an electric generation supplier in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and will no longer do so.

6. As of the date of this Petition, DES is not aware of any outstanding formal complaints against it pending before the Commission.

7. Accordingly, DES respectfully requests authorization to abandon its license as an EGS in the Commonwealth. It should be noted that this request should not be considered to have any impact on DES's separate license (A-125002) as a natural gas supplier, as it intends to continue pursuing that business indefinitely.

WHEREFORE, Dominion Retail, Inc. respectfully requests that its Petition requesting that it be authorized to abandon its electric generation supplier license be granted and that the Commission issue an Order to that effect.




