**PREHEARING CONFERENCE MEMORANDUM OF
THE PENNSYLVANIA STATE UNIVERSITY**

On December 8, 2015, a Notice was issued by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) setting a Prehearing Conference in the above-captioned proceeding for Tuesday, January 5, 2016 before the Honorable Elizabeth H. Barnes. By Order dated December 18, 2015, ALJ Barnes directed parties to submit a prehearing conference memorandum by December 30, 2015.

The Pennsylvania State University (“PSU”), by and through its attorneys in this matter, Hawke McKeon & Sniscak LLP, hereby submits its Prehearing Conference Memorandum.

II. HISTORY OF THE PROCEEDING

On November 30, 2015, Metropolitan Edison Company ("Met-Ed"), Pennsylvania Electric Company ("Penelec"), Pennsylvania Power Company ("Penn Power"), and West Penn Power Company ("West Penn") (collectively, "First Energy" or "the Companies") filed a Joint Petition for Consolidation of Proceedings and Approval of Energy Efficiency and Conservation Plans Phase III ("Phase III Plans"). On December 30, 2015, PSU filed a Petition to Intervene with the Commission, contending that as a major customer of West Penn for a number of separate accounts, PSU will be substantially and directly affected by any decision, final order or settlement in this matter and will be bound thereby.

III. SETTLEMENT

There have been no settlement discussions to date, but PSU is willing to participate in settlement discussions with the other parties.

IV. DISCOVERY

PSU will work with all parties to this proceeding to develop a mutually-agreeable discovery plan and schedule, including but not limited to modifications to regulations or procedures.

V. SCHEDULE

PSU is willing to work with the parties to develop a schedule that gives sufficient time for necessary discovery and submission of testimony.

PSU continues to review the filing as to whether it is reasonable, appropriate and consistent with statutory requirements and regulatory principles. Moreover, PSU has an interest


in changes other parties may propose. PSU's position will be finalized in its evidence and briefs submitted under the schedule developed in this case.
