**PETITION TO WITHDRAW OF CITIZEN POWER, INC. AND NOTICE OF
CHANGE IN ADDRESS**

1. Citizen Power, Inc. ("Citizen Power") hereby Petitions to Withdraw from the above-captioned proceeding pursuant to the provisions of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC" or "Commission"), 52 Pa. Code Section 5.94 and the Public Utility Code.
2. On October 13, 2015, Citizen Power Petitioned to Intervene in the above-captioned proceeding. This Petition was approved on October 13, 2015, and subsequently Citizen Power has been an active participant in this proceeding.
3. Citizen Power has temporarily suspended their legal advocacy operations effective October 31, 2016 due to funding shortages. Therefore, Citizen Power is unable to continue participating in this proceeding.
4. Citizen Power's main issues in this proceeding concern the question of whether the ADMS system has a positive net benefit and how the cost of the ADMS system should be allocated between ratepayers. The Office of Consumer Advocate is actively participating in this case and has addressed both of these issues.
