Consolidated Edison Solutions, Inc. (“ConEdison Solutions”) hereby submits the following information in response to the Commission’s data requests forwarded via E-mail on November 3, 2016 from Jeffrey McCracken. These responses were previously provide via return E-mail on November 15, 2016 and are now submitted as a formal filing in the above-captioned docket.

**DATA REQUESTS:**

1. Do you have a timeline for this transfer?

ConEdison Solutions’ Response:

Yes. Currently, ConEdison Solutions continues to exist as a legal entity and holds a valid EGS license in PA (Lic. # A-110055). During the transition, ConEdison Solutions will continue to serve all of its customers under its current PUC license and registration arrangements with the various PA EDCs. The current planned timeline involves the assignment of customers from ConEdison Solutions to Constellation New Energy during two phases scheduled to occur in 2017. Residential customers are schedule to be transferred during the first quarter of 2017. This will involve the enrollment of customers onto the Constellation entity during February and March, with the goal of moving all customers by the end of March 2017. For commercial and industrial customers, the current plan is to assign customers in November 2017.

We are aware of the requirements regarding the transfer/assignment of customers set forth in the PUC’s 1998 Order on Interim Guidelines (Docket No. M-00960890F0013, at 9 (Aug. 13, 1998) (“Order on Interim Guidelines”, [http://www.puc.state.pa.us/electric/pdf/OCMO/Order-IG\\_Not\\_EGS\\_OCACSC081398.pdf](http://www.puc.state.pa.us/electric/pdf/OCMO/Order-IG_Not_EGS_OCACSC081398.pdf)). As required, we will provide affected customers with a notice describing the assignment at least 30 days before the assignment occurs. A copy of the notice template that we plan to use is attached as “Exhibit A”. Constellation will honor the customer’s existing terms and conditions, including pricing after the assignment for the remainder of the customer’s contract term.

2. Will ConEdison Solutions be abandoning its license in PA?


ConEdison Solutions' Response:

Once the transition is fully completed, ConEdison Solutions does not intend to continue to operate as an EGS. Accordingly ConEdison Solutions does plan to eventually file to abandon its license. However, the timing of this abandonment is likely to lag behind the schedule for the operational transfer of customers. ConEdison Solutions will need to maintain its license to complete any contractual commitments to provide service to customers until all remaining customers are either transferred to Constellation or the term of the contract with ConEdison Solutions ends. ConEdison Solutions likely will not be in a position to abandon its PA EGS license until sometime in 2018.

Additionally, on September 2, 2016, ConEdison Solutions submitted a prior filing in the above-referenced docket regarding the purchase of ConEdison Solutions by Exelon. Attached hereto as Exhibit "B" is a copy of the Proof of Service for the letter filing.


