In accordance with its continuing obligations under Section 54.34 of the Regulations of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (the "Commission") governing Electricity Generation Supplier Licensing, Green Mountain Energy Resources L.L.C. (the "Company") hereby informs the Commission of a material change in the information required in the Company's license application. Effective October 5, 1998, Douglas G. Hyde resigned as President of the Company and M. David White became the Company's President, Chief Executive Officer and Chief Financial Officer. Mr. White's age and business experience for the past five years is as follows: Age: 37 - President and Chief-Executive Officer, Green Mountain Energy Resources since October 5, 1998; Senior Vice President, Investment Banking Division, Donaldson, Lufkin & Jenrette from January 1998 until October 5, 1998 when he resigned to accept his current position, Director, Investment Banking Division, Merrill Lynch & Co. from June 1997 to December 1997; Vice President of Finance, Boston Chicken Inc. from December 1994 to June 1997; Director, Investment Banking Division, Merrill Lynch & Co. from January 1, 1993 to December of 1994. Mr. Hyde will continue to serve as a member of the Company's Management Committee and will act as a consultant to the Company.

In addition to the material change noted above, Exhibit 6 of the Company's license application should be updated to reflect the current titles of the Company's remaining officers:

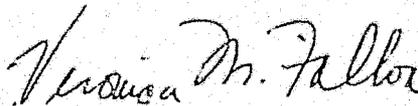
