On January 14, 1999, the Commission issued a permanent license at Docket No. A-110073, authorizing Green Mountain Energy Resources, L.L.C. the right to begin to offer, render, furnish or supply electric generation supplier services to the public within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

On June 18, 1999 Green Mountain Energy Resources, L.L.C. merged with and into GreenMountain.com Company. GreenMountain.com Company formally changed its name to Green Mountain Energy Company on October 4, 2000.




