RE: License Bond or Other Financial Security

Dear Ms. Tighe:

Pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. §2809(c), no electric supplier license shall remain in force unless the licensee furnishes a bond or other security approved by the Commission to ensure the financial responsibility of the electric generation supplier and the supply of electricity at retail. The Commission's records indicate that the bond or other approved security provided by Hess Energy, Inc. expires on 3/31/02.

The Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code §54.40(d) require "the security level for each licensee will be reviewed annually and modified primarily based upon the licensee's reported annual gross receipts information. The security level will be 10% of the licensee's reported gross receipts." The minimum security level provided may not be less than the initial security level provided when the license was granted. Unless approved by the Commission, the initial security level is \$250,000.

The Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code §54.39(b) require a licensee to file an annual report on or before April 30 of each year, for the previous calendar year, in order to comply with 66 Pa. C.S. §2810(c)(6). This report discloses the total amount of gross receipts from the sale of electricity and the total amount of electricity sold during the preceding calendar year. You must use this same information in calculating the appropriate security level necessary to maintain your license.

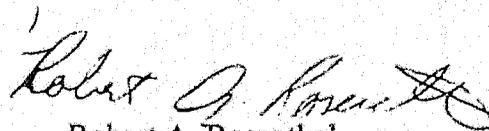
In order for your company to maintain its status as a licensed electric supplier in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, it must provide proof to the Commission that a bond or other approved security has been obtained.

Your response in this matter is requested within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter. Submit your response to the Commission's Secretary. Additionally, fax a copy of your response to James Shurskis at (717) 787-4750, Bureau of Fixed Utility Services.

Failure to respond to this matter within fifteen (15) days will cause Commission staff to initiate a formal proceeding, that may lead to the following: cancellation of your company's electric supplier license, removal of your information from the Commission's website and notification to all electric distribution companies, in which your company is licensed to do business, of the cancellation of the license.

Hess Energy, Inc. ("HEI") and Amerada Hess Corporation ("AHC") jointly submit this Application to the Commission under 66 Pa. C.S. §2809(d), 52 Pa. Code §§54.40(c) and (d) and 54.41, requesting the Commission's approval of the transfer of an Electric Generation Supplier ("EGS") license, abandonment of service of a second and duplicative EGS license and the modification of the security level bond requirement for its surviving EGS license.

In support of its' Application, HEI and AHC state as follows:

A. Background

I. On June 11, 1997, the Commission granted Eastern Power Distribution, Inc. ("EPDI") an EGS license to at A-110005 to operate as a supplier in the Commonwealth, the first EGS license to be issued by this Commission. On August 13, 1998, the Commission granted another EGS license to AHC, at A-110084. On May 21, 1998, EPDI notified the Commission that it had changed its name to Statoil Energy Services, Inc ("SESI"). On April 1, 2000, HEI notified the Commission of a change in the name of the licensee under the EGS license at A-110005 from SESI to HEI, following the acquisition of the outstanding equity of SESI by AHC.

Accordingly, currently, HEI holds an EGS license at A-110005 and its affiliate AHC holds an EGS license at A-110084.

B. Transfer of License

2. The HEI/AHC corporate family only require one EGS license under the Company's current and planned future operations. All existing and planned future operations will be conducted under the AHC brand name as a result of the merger of HEI into AHC. AHC/HEI desire to retain the EGS license issued at A-110005 and transfer that license from HEI to AHC so as to conform to the Company's current and planned future operations. AHC has already demonstrated to the Commission's satisfaction the Company's fitness to hold an EGS license. In this regard, AHC's Application at A-110084 is attached hereto and incorporated by reference.

C. Abandonment of License

3. Upon approval of the transfer, the license already held by AHC at A-110084 will no longer be useful and will be duplicative. For this reason, AHC requests Commission approval of the abandonment of the EGS license at A-110084 and the cancellation of that license on a prospective basis.

4. Commission regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 54.41(b) establish customer and EDC notice requirements applicable to the abandonment of a license. However, because the licensee here, HEI, is not serving any customers under the license, these requirements should not be viewed as applicable. However, if the Commission finds that the regulation is applicable, it should be waived since application of the regulation would not serve any purpose here.

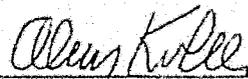
D. Reduction of Security

5. The license currently held by HEI (for which this Application seeks a transfer to AHC) at A-110005 has been in effect for over two years and has maintained a security bond in the amount of \$250,000. Under 52 Pa. Code § 54 40(d), "After the first year that the license is in effect, the security level for each licensee will be reviewed annually and modified primarily based on the licensee's reported annual gross receipts information. The security level will be 10% of the licensee's reported gross receipts. A licensee may seek approval from the Commission of an alternative level of bonding commensurate with the nature and scope of its operations." As recently reported to the Commission in the Assessment Report for calendar year 2001 (attached hereto), the consolidated gross receipts in Pennsylvania of AHC and HEI totaled \$389,329.07 for the 2001 calendar year. Furthermore, neither company is currently serving customers in Pennsylvania. Although AHC plans to operate under its license in the near future, it does not plan to generate a level of gross receipts which would justify a large amount of required security. Accordingly, AHC requests that the \$250,000 security level currently carried under the license be reduced to \$10,000. If the Commission finds it necessary to retain a security requirement greater than this level, AHC requests that the security level be reduced to no more than \$40,000, which is approximately 10% of the licensees' consolidated income for 2001.

6. The relief requested herein will have no impact on customers and is fully consistent with the public interest.

WHEREFORE, for all the foregoing reasons, HEI and AHC respectfully request the Commission grant this Application and (1) authorize the transfer of HEI's license A-110005 to AHC, (2) reduce the bond security level under license A-110005 to \$10,000; and, (3) authorize the abandonment of the EGS license currently held by AHC at A-110084
