





Dear Ms. Weinberger:

Pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. §2809(c), no electric supplier license shall remain in force unless the licensee furnishes a bond or other security approved by the Commission to ensure the financial responsibility of the electric generation supplier and the supply of electricity at retail. The Commission's records indicate that the bond or other approved security provided by Amerada Hess Corporation expires on 3/31/2004.

The Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code §54.40(d) require "the security level for each licensee will be reviewed annually and modified primarily based upon the licensee's reported annual gross receipts information. The security level will be 10% of the licensee's reported gross receipts." The minimum security level provided may not be less than the initial security level provided when the license was granted. Unless approved by the Commission, the initial security level is \$250,000.

The Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code §54.39(b) require a licensee to file an annual report on or before April 30 of each year, for the previous calendar year, in order to comply with 66 Pa. C.S. §2810(c)(6). This report discloses the total amount of gross receipts from the sale of electricity and the total amount of electricity sold during the preceding calendar year. You must use this same information in calculating the appropriate security level necessary to maintain your license.


In order for your company to maintain its status as a licensed electric supplier in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, it must provide proof to the Commission that a bond or other approved security has been obtained.

Your response in this matter is requested within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter. Submit your response to the Commission's Secretary. Additionally, fax a copy of your response to James Shurskis at (717) 787-4750, Bureau of Fixed Utility Services.

Failure to respond to this matter within fifteen (15) days will cause Commission staff to initiate a formal proceeding, that may lead to the following: cancellation of your company's electric supplier license, removal of your information from the Commission's website and notification to all electric distribution companies, in which your company is licensed to do business, of the cancellation of the license.



RE: Notification of Change to Financial Data

Dear Secretary McNulty:

This shall serve as formal notification by Amerada Hess Corporation ("Hess") of a change in its long-term debt and commercial paper rating. On February 13, 2004, Moody's Investor Services downgraded Hess' rating to Ba1.

Although Hess is required simply to provide notification of such changes to its financial data, Hess values our relationship with Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, and would therefore like to take this opportunity to provide you with additional information regarding Hess's credit and financial positions that will offer a more complete account of our overall financial strength.

Over the past two years Hess has reduced its debt by \$1.7 billion, we have issued \$675 million of equity in November of last year, and reduced our debt to capital ratio to 42% at year-end 2003 from 54% at year-end 2002. Hess' net income at 2003 year end was \$643 million.

In addition, Hess' liquidity is outstanding with \$518 million cash on hand at year-end 2003, plus an unused, \$1.5 billion senior unsecured bank facility maturing in January, 2006, aggregating in excess of \$2.0 billion of cash immediately available.

An important factor to note is that Moody's opinion of Hess stands in stark contrast to the ratings of the other two nationally recognized statistical rating organizations sanctioned by the U. S. Securities and Exchange Commission. Hess' long term debt has been rated BBB by Standard & Poor's and BBB- by Fitch.

Lastly, Goldman Sachs, JP Morgan, Deutsche Bank and Bank of America have all recently favorably reviewed Hess' common stock value and Dun & Bradstreet's most recent annual rating of Hess is 5A2, meaning good financial condition

Again, Hess continues to maintain a strong financial position and looks forward to continuing our valuable business relationship with Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission. Dear Mr. Kooper:

Pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. §2809(c), no electric supplier license shall remain in force unless the licensee furnishes a bond or other security approved by the Commission to ensure the financial responsibility of the electric generation supplier and the supply of electricity at retail. The Commission's records indicate that the bond or other approved security provided by Amerada Hess Corporation expires on March 31, 2005.

The Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code §54.40(d) require "the security level for each licensee will be reviewed annually and modified primarily based upon the licensee's reported annual gross receipts information. The security level will be 10% of the licensee's reported gross receipts." The minimum security level provided may not be less than the initial security level provided when the license was granted. Unless approved by the Commission, the initial security level is \$250,000.

The Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code §54.39(b) require a licensee to file an annual report on or before April 30 of each year, for the previous calendar year, in order to comply with 66 Pa. C.S. §2810(e)(6). This report discloses the total amount of gross receipts from the sale of electricity and the total amount of electricity sold during the preceding calendar year. You must use this same information in calculating the appropriate security level necessary to maintain your license.

In order for your company to maintain its status as a licensed electric supplier in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, it must provide proof to the Commission that a bond or other approved security has been obtained.
