BY THE COMMISSION:

On April 15, 2002, Amerada Hess Corporation ("AHC") and Hess Energy, Inc. ("HEI") filed a Joint Application, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §54.40(c), §54.40 (d) and §54.41. First, the Application requests that the Commission approve the transfer of the electric generation supplier ("EGS") license at Docket No. A-110005 from HEI to AHC. Second, the Application requests that the Commission approve the abandonment of AHC's EGS license at Docket No. A-110084. Finally, the Application requests that the Commission approve a reduction in the amount of security bond held pursuant to 66 Pa.

C.S. §2809 for the license at Docket No. A-110005 after the license is transferred to AHC. In the Application AHC also requests approval for a security bond in the range of \$10,000 to \$40,000.

HEI is an electric generation supplier in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, at Docket No. A-110005. HEI is licensed as a generator and supplier of electric power, a broker/marketer engaged in the business of supplying electricity, and an aggregator engaged in the business of supplying electricity, providing services to industrial and commercial customers in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. By Order entered May 8, 1997, HEI was granted an interim license, which became effective on June 11, 1997, under a prior name of Eastern Power Distribution, Inc. By Secretarial Letter, on August 18, 1998, the Commission approved the transfer of the license to Statoil Energy Services, Inc. ("Statoil"). By Order entered January 14, 1999, the Commission granted Statoil a permanent license. By Secretarial Letter, on June 1, 2000, the Commission approved a name change on the license to Hess Energy, Inc.

AHC is a generation electricity supplier in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, at Docket No. A-110084. AHC is licensed as a broker/marketer engaged in the business of supplying electricity to commercial, industrial and governmental customers in the service territories of GPU Energy, PECO Energy Company, PPL Electric Utilities Corporation, and UGI Utilities, Inc. By Order entered August 13, 1998, the Commission granted AHC an interim license. By Order entered January 14, 1999, the Commission granted AHC a permanent license.

AHC requests, that if the Commission approves the transfer of the license at Docket No. A-110005, that the Commission also approve a bonding level in the range of \$10,000 to \$40,000 for that license, based on AHC's planned level of gross receipts in the near future. In support of the requests, AHC and HEI provided information concerning their business operations. The information provided includes documentation

concerning recent and future gross receipts, recent and future gross receipts taxes, customer and public notification, marketing activities and bonding.

Other EGSs have inquired about reducing their bond level to something less than the \$250,000 level required in the initial application. The Commission has approved several of these requests where the EGS is licensed as a broker/marketer, acts strictly as an energy consultant or a buyer's agent, and does not take title to electricity. Conversely, the Commission denied the request of an EGS that was licensed both as a broker/marketer and as an aggregator. Aggregators can take title to electricity. Since the license at Docket No. A-110005 will allow AHC to operate as a generator and supplier of electricity, a broker/marketer, as well as an aggregator, the Commission believes that a bonding level of less than \$250,000 is not appropriate.

HEI and AHC state that they were not serving any customers in the Commonwealth when the Joint Application was filed with the Commission on April 15, 2002. Also, HEI states that it will not engage in any marketing activities while the license transfer is being processed. Therefore, we believe that the transfer of the license at Docket No. A-110005 from HEI to AHC and the voluntary relinquishment and abandonment of HEI's license at Docket No. A-110084 will have no impact on the public, electric distribution utilities or providers of last resort. Accordingly, the Commission will waive the notification provisions of 52 Pa. Code §54.41(b) and the provisions of the Interim Guidelines Regarding Notification by an Electric Generation Supplier of Operational Changes Affecting Customer Service and Contracts, at Docket No. M-00960890F0013; **THEREFORE,**

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the Joint Application to Transfer an EGS License filed by Amerada Hess Corporation and Hess Energy, Inc. on April 15, 2002 is hereby granted.

2. That the permanent EGS license held by Hess Energy, Inc. at Docket No. A-110005 is hereby transferred to Amerada Hess Corporation.

3. That the Joint Application of Amerada Hess Corporation to reduce the amount of security bond held pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. §2809, is hereby denied.

4. That Amerada Hess Corporation submits a security bond or other approved security in the amount of \$250,000 within 15 days of the entry date of this Order.

5. That the Joint Application to Abandon filed by Amerada Hess Corporation on April 15, 2002 is hereby granted.

6. That the permanent EGS license held by Amerada Hess Corporation at Docket No. A-110084 is hereby cancelled.

7. That the notification provisions under 52 Pa. Code Section 54.41(b) are waived consistent with the discussion in this Order.

8. That notification provisions of the Interim Guidelines Regarding Notification by an Electric Generation Supplier of Operational Changes Affecting Customer Service and Contracts, at Docket No. M-00960890F0013, are waived consistent with the discussion in this Order.

9. That the Secretary shall strike Hess Energy, Inc.'s name from all active utility lists maintained by the Annual Report Section of the Secretary's Bureau and the Assessment Section of the Bureau of Administrative Services.


10. That if there are no outstanding complaints against Hess Energy, Inc.

RE: License Bond or Other Financial Security

Dear Mr. LaGuardia:

Pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. §2809(c), no electric supplier license shall remain in force unless the licensee furnishes a bond or other security approved by the Commission to ensure the financial responsibility of the electric generation supplier and the supply of electricity at retail. The Commission's records indicate that the bond or other approved security provided by Amerada Hess Corporation expires on 3/31/2003.

The Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code §54.40(d) require "the security level for each licensee will be reviewed annually and modified primarily based upon the licensee's reported annual gross receipts information. The security level will be 10% of the licensee's reported gross receipts." The minimum security level provided may not be less than the initial security level provided when the license was granted. Unless approved by the Commission, the initial security level is \$250,000.

The Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code §54.39(b) require a licensee to file an annual report on or before April 30 of each year, for the previous calendar year, in order to comply with 66 Pa. C.S. §2810(c)(6). This report discloses the total amount of gross receipts from the sale of electricity and the total amount of electricity sold during the preceding calendar year. You must use this same information in calculating the appropriate security level necessary to maintain your license.

In order for your company to maintain its status as a licensed electric supplier in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, it must provide proof to the Commission that a bond or other approved security has been obtained.

Your response in this matter is requested within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter. Submit your response to the Commission's Secretary. Additionally, fax a copy of your response to James Shurskis at (717) 787-4750, Bureau of Fixed Utility Services.

Failure to respond to this matter within fifteen (15) days will cause Commission staff to initiate a formal proceeding, that may lead to the following: cancellation of your company's electric supplier license, removal of your information from the Commission's website and notification to all electric distribution companies, in which your company is licensed to do business, of the cancellation of the license.
