Enclosed for filing are the comments of FirstEnergy Solutions Corp. in the above referenced matter, consistent with the Commission's instructions as set forth in the Proposed Rulemaking that was published in the Pennsylvania Bulletin on March 24, 2018 (48 Pa.B. 1696).

FirstEnergy Solutions Corp. ("FES") appreciates the efforts the Commission has taken to clarify the rules related to (i) customer information regulations pertaining to standards and pricing practices for retail electricity services; (ii) disclosure statements for residential and small business customers; (iii) marketing and sales activities; and (iv) notices of contract expiration or changes in terms. FES is not opposed to the proposed changes and believes that standardization of such regulations with those for the natural gas industry will reduce potential customer confusion for those customers dealing with both commodities.

FES further believes that clarification of terms and conditions, which, in the past, may have caused confusion for the customer, will enhance the customer's shopping experience, thus, benefitting the overall competitive electric generation market in Pennsylvania.
