I am writing to request a reduction in the level of security The Energy Cooperative Association of Pennsylvania (ECAP) is required to provide in order to operate as electric generation supplier in Pennsylvania. ECAP currently provides a level of security equivalent to 10% of the previous years reported gross receipts or \$250,000, whichever amount is greater. ECAP is requesting to provide security in the amount of 5% of the most recent 12 months of revenue, or \$250,000, whichever amount is greater. As outlined in the Bonding Requirements – Final Order (M-2013-2393141) ECAP has included the following information.

- 1) Gross revenues for the sale of electricity to retail customers in Pennsylvania for the most recent 12 months (**Attached**)
- 2) Amount of gross receipts taxes that the EGS has prepaid towards its estimated revenues for the current calendar year (**\$0**)
- 3) Tax status letter of good standing from the Department of Revenue (**Attached**)
- 4) Signed Certificate of Service to all parties affected by the application (**Attached**)
- 5) AEPS compliance data from the most recent 12 months (**Attached**)
- 6) \$350 filing fee
