

**Pennsylvania Carrier Working Group
February, 2006 Meeting Notes**

No amendments to the agenda.

January public minutes adopted.

No comments on the websites.

E/U Migration Guideline review is nearing completion. Currently editing the guidelines, only requiring updates in electronic form. This effort should be complete for the next meeting scheduled in April.

DL/WP – The subcommittee met recently and members are reviewing remedy proposals. The subcommittee is scheduled to meet on 2/13 to further review proposals.

BI-6, 7, 8 Proposals – A party has not had an opportunity to review the proposals due to personnel changes.

JSC meeting scheduled for 2/15 at 10:00 AM continuing on provisioning issues.

No NY CWG updates.

PUC requested proposal for proceeding on KS test that was presented at the last NY CWG meeting. A party will inquire with NY PSC staff as to any concerns with sharing the proposed work plan.

There was consensus on a proposal to meet less frequently. The proposal is that the regular meetings will be every other month on the “even” months. All parties are to continue to carry the first Tuesday of every month on their calendars for the PA CWG meeting. At each even month meeting a decision will be made whether a meeting is required prior to the next even month. If no additional meeting is needed, the next first Tuesday is freed up. If a meeting is needed, it stays on the schedule and a meeting occurs on the “odd” month.

For March, there may be a meeting if the NY PSC issues an order on the PAP. A notice will be emailed indicating such a requirement if an order is issued.

There was a discussion of a party’s proposal for adoption of the NY PSC December 2005 order. Consensus was to follow the proposal as it would not disrupt current operation of the PAP and did not require future true-ups.
