

**Pennsylvania Carrier Working Group
March, 2005 Public Minutes**

Report on End user Migration Guideline – Order issued Feb 3 effective Feb 9
PUC Rulemaking L-00030163. (for web search)

A Party filed petition for reconsideration the Thursday before the March CWG meeting.
Concerns as follows:

- The order placed some coordination roles on underlying NSP.
- IRRC comments related to use of CSR information to contact customers within 45 days of transfer.
- Time for handling a LSC (intervals requested but not ordered and no comments regarding the request).

Parties have not been able to come to consensus on the Directory Listing document.
OSBA and OCA plan on scheduling another conference call to discuss new issue that arose.

Hot Cuts – Secretarial Letter permitting delayed implementation of NY guideline changes is circulating. Party reported on a partial settlement related to hot cut processes in the hot cut proceeding that prompted a delayed filing.

Implementation of the last set of guidelines is on target. They are implemented for the February 2005 data month.

Audit – Parties will confer on issues 25, 29, 32, 33, 66 and 69 and report back to the PA CWG.

JSC – Ordering meeting held last Friday, some issues resolved and some new ones were added as work items. Two domains, PO and NP are completed.

NY CWG – Non-consensus write-ups on two items due 3/4/05. Filing expected in NY in the April session which will then flow through to the other East states.

PAP document – amended Appendix F. PA PUC wanted more clarity and staff is satisfied with the edits.

LSI Failures – no issues were uncovered that were affected the metric. The reported score is in accordance with the way the metric is defined in the Guidelines.

Future Meeting Administration - Since the agenda has been short and there appears to be no substantive issues it was recommended that we continue to schedule conference calls for this group. Should there be any substantive issues we can schedule a face to face meeting. This will be added as an agenda item for April's meeting to discuss implementation.
