

**Pennsylvania Carrier Working Group
June 2006 Public Meeting Notes**

- April Public Minutes adopted.
- No comments on websites.
- A report was made on the status of CLEC to CLEC end user migration guideline review. Permanent regulations are fairly detailed. Much of what is in the narrative section of the guidelines is repetitive to the regulation. The heart of the guidelines relate to various CLEC to CLEC migration scenarios and the operational requirements to place an order. These may be dated. ATIS/OBF issued migration guidelines that are more detailed and cover additional scenarios.

Maintaining the PA Migration Guidelines will require a party take on responsibility to update for current LSOG versions. There is no resource available to continue this work. At the last sub-committee meeting the consensus of the participating industry parties was to discontinue the work on the PA Guidelines and rely upon industry standards. A party indicated the group must report to the Commission if the parties are to rely upon the ATIS/OBF document, and point the industry to those guidelines.

- A party reported that there have been two conference calls and the DL/WP sub-group work continues to move forward.
- JSC last session May 8 on ordering and provisioning issues. Next meeting is June 8. Maryland collaborative moving 16 new issues from a recent audit into the JSC.
- NY CWG has a number of Administrative Changes pending a NY Commission meeting and subsequent order.
- K-S test - NY Statistics Group discussed the treatment of ties. Some discussion on exact significance pending this week's meeting.
- PAP Technical Conference in NY. Bridge opened for monitoring only. The Technical Conference is in Albany, NY.
