

**Pennsylvania Carrier Working Group
August, 2006 Public Minutes**

- No changes to agenda
- Public minutes adopted
- No website comments
- End User Migration Guidelines: A party at the OP-12 forum raised subject of End User Migration Guidelines and updated that group with CWG finding that maintenance of guidelines would be cumbersome and no party was willing to take on the responsibility to provide resources required to continually update the guidelines so they are current to OSS software releases used in the industry. Outstanding question is whether the PUC will substitute ATIS guidelines for the guidelines that were previously referenced.

A party opposed the idea of the PUC putting the force of regulation behind those guidelines and suggested that the PUC point to those guidelines as an industry standard. Staff suggested that the CWG provide a recommendation to the PUC. Another party suggested that the ATIS guidelines be referenced as the industry standard. No other party had a recommendation and the Staff will take the recommendation that the ATIS guidelines be referenced as an industry standard as the CWG recommendation to the PUC.

- No comment on monthly C2C reported results.
- DL/WP – A party gave an update from the last full meeting of the sub-committee. Parties were recommended to negotiate and try to come to resolution on outstanding issues and present a proposal to the sub-committee. Other parties suggested they are not necessarily aligned with the outcome. Parties discussed the ramifications of a spin-off of Directory Services by the ILEC.
- Regulatory Updates – A party made a presentation regarding the C2C filing made on July 14
- Billing metric pending action in NY State.
- JSC – Meetings continue next meeting Aug. 8 Provisioning Domain being discussed
- No NY CWG updates.
- K-S test analysis proceeding in NY with fewer resources than expected.

- The 2006 PAP proposal was issued by NY PSC Staff, with comments/reply comments under NY PSC consideration.
