

**Pennsylvania Carrier Working Group
October, 2005 Public Meeting Minutes**

Date: October 4, 2005
Time: 10:00 AM
Place: Conference Call

September public minutes were adopted with some amendments. They will be reflected on the public minutes posted to the PA PUC web site.

End User migration guidelines – The subcommittee is updating the EUMG to have them reflect business rules and formats that are consistent with the most recent LSOG versions and to make them consistent with the recent PA Changing LSPs rulemaking. Subcommittee wanted some assurance that the EUMG will be effective/enforceable before they expended effort to modify them. There were concerns that only a few LECs actually abided by the EUMG while other LECs choose to disregard them. The PUC Staff explained that unless there is rulemaking, there is no assurance that the EUMG will be enforceable. Making the EUMG “rules” was rejected by the industry during the Changing LSPs collaboratives and rulemaking. Adoption of the EUMG through a policy statement, by commission order, etc., is what is underconsideration now.

Changing Local Service Providers Regulations – A letter from the Bureau of Consumer Service is forthcoming. The subject of the letter is a request that LECs confirm they have placed contact information on the web site.

Directory Listings/White Pages Subcommittee met on Sept 30 to discuss a proposal circulated by one of the parties. A follow-up meeting is scheduled for Oct 14.

PA Regulatory Update - The latest order was entered last month. C2C updates and compliance filing made on Sept 27.

Data Center outage – There was no representative in attendance to report out. A party noted that an extensive readout was provided at the September Change Management Meeting. The same party noted the report detailed all the breakdowns that were being pursued; including root cause of mechanical and process breakdowns.

Billing metric proposals – A party will continue to attempt to schedule a follow up meeting.

JSC – A party will send out dates to schedule meetings to address the outstanding issues.

There are no new agenda items for November’s meeting.
