

PJ45039: SECURITY SCRIPT WIZARD UPDATES THE SECURITY ON SUBFOLDERS

APAR status

Error description

Security Script Wizard updates the security on subfolders

Steps to reproduce

1. Using "IBM Administrative Console for Content Platform Engine" (ACCE) navigate to an object store and create a folder ("myFolder") under the root folder.
2. Run the "Security Script Wizard" by right clicking on the object store and selecting "Run Security Script Wizard"
3. Download the SecurityWizardScript.zip and extract it. Then select UpdateOSSecurity.json and SecurityScript.js accordingly and click "Next"
4. Add a new user to each role and click "Next"
5. Click "Finish"

Note in the script output there is an entry for the folder from step 1. "Get Folder myFolder". Navigating to the myFolder's security tab will also show the security is updated.

Local fix

The SecurityScript.js can be modified to skip updating the subfolder security.

Comment out the following lines and run the security script wizard:
